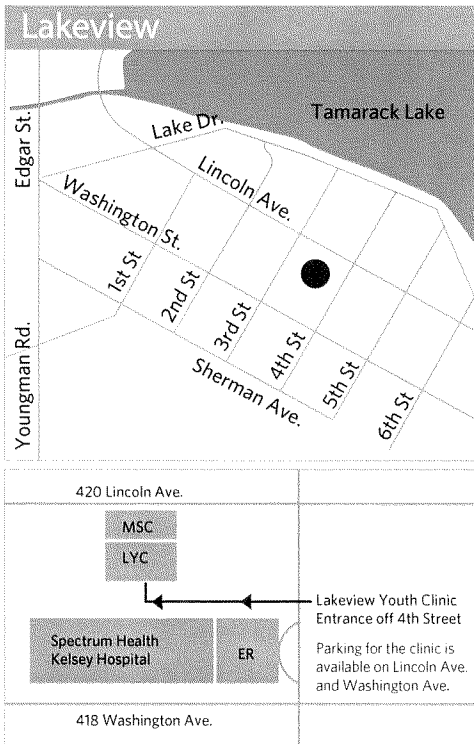
The Lakeview Youth Clinic will be open the following days and times on a weekly basis:

Friday 10 am to 6 p.m.

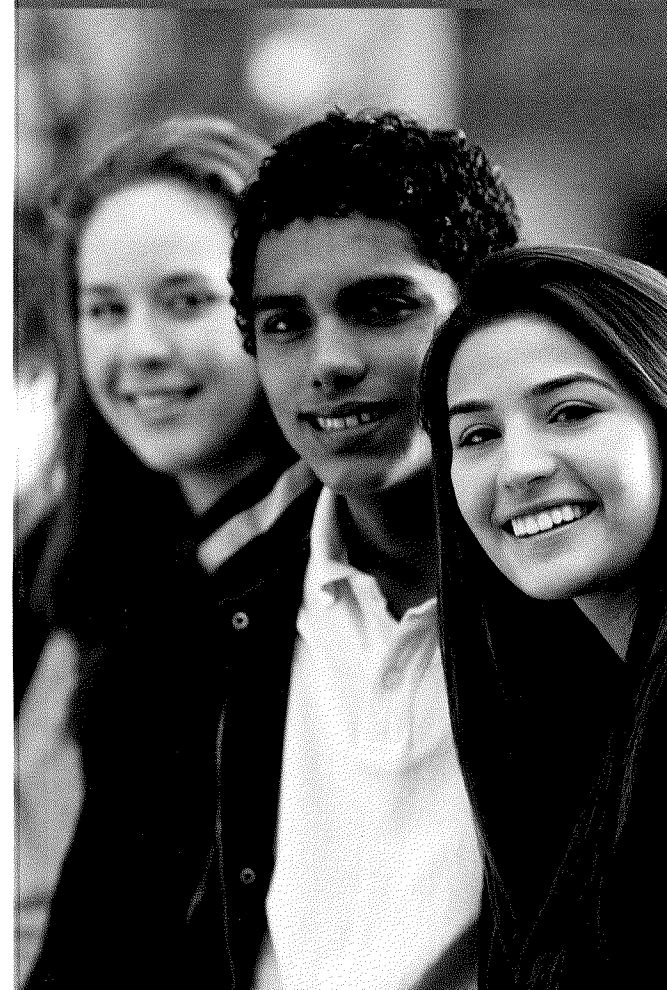

Health care services designed for 10 to 21 year-olds

Keeping adolescents healthy, safe and empowered to make smart life and health choices is a greater challenge now more than ever. Additionally, it can be very difficult for young adults in rural communities to find relevant resources to meet their needs in a safe, confidential setting.

A partner with Lakeview Community Schools, the Lakeview Youth Clinic is designed to address the unique needs – medical, social-emotional, developmental – of adolescents ages 10 to 21. Welcoming young adults from all communities and school districts, our dedicated team includes physicians, dentists, nursing, nutritional and social work professionals.

Our approach to care is team-based, allowing the young adult, his or her parents and the medical provider to become partners in decision making. Additionally, the staff of Lakeview Youth Clinic is highly involved in the surrounding communities and has access to resources such as social service agencies and human services organizations.

Services

Lakeview Youth Clinic offers services designed to meet the needs of the youth population. Our services and specialties* include:

- Primary Care
- Comprehensive routine health care
- Immunizations (including Gardasil, Tetanus, Meningococcal)
- Sports physicals
- Annual physicals
- Sexually transmitted infections
- Substance abuse
- Depression and anxiety
- Eating disorders and obesity
- Health education
- Illness and Injury treatment
- Life skills and goal setting
- Relationship, interpersonal, school and behavioral issues
- Patient advocacy with outside agencies
- Referrals to specialized physicians, mental health professionals and dentists

*Michigan law requires that some services be offered to teens privately. If there is any situation that could result in harm to themselves or others, or if someone is hurting them, our staff will report the situation as required by law.

Consent

Parental consent is required to receive all services, except those protected by Michigan Law. Consent forms for service are available at the Lakeview Youth Clinic and at area supporting schools.

Payment

The Lakeview Youth Clinic accepts all insurance types, including MIChild and Healthy Kids. We have a sliding scale fee and provide service regardless of ability to pay. All employees of the Lakeview Youth Clinic are able to assist under or uninsured families with completing the Healthy Kids/MIChild application.
